Rules on how to get points you missed on test 1 back.

- 1. You can get up to half of the points you missed on test 1 back.
- 2. The deadline is 7 pm Friday, October 12.
- 3. To get half of the missed points back for a specific problem, you need to show me that you can do this type of the problem correctly. For example, if you missed a total of 8 points on problem 3 from the test, you can get 4 out of these 8 points back. For this you have to solve a another problem which will be assign to you. This new problem will be similar, but not the same, and it will have the same number of parts as the original test problem. You will have to do all parts correctly to receive credit for this problem.
- 4. You can work on one or more problem at a time and get credit for each problem separately. You have to do your work in a classroom or in my office under my supervision.
- 5. No notes, textbooks, calculators, and other electronic devices will be allowed while you are working on a problem (I will make sure that the calculations are simple enough).
- 6. I will offer several opportunities for students to come and work on problems. The first two opportunities are Thursday, September 26, 2-3:30 pm in my office in TUC 300 and Friday, September 27, 5-6 in TUC 244 (our classroom).
